Aroa STET provides specialist support for children unable to access school or those educated via Education Otherwise Than In School/College (EOTIS/C). Our team includes Specialist SEND Mentors, Consultant Mentors and Educational Psychologists, delivering therapeutic and bespoke education within the home and community, tailored to each child's needs.

HOW STET WORKS:

Referral Process:

- Parents/carers, local authorities, or schools can make a referral.
- Once accepted, a consultation is arranged with an Educational Psychologist or Team Manager

Personalised Support Plan:

- A Consultant Mentor is assigned to oversee the child's programme.
- A First Stage Consultation sets out the plan, transition phase, and introduces the SEND Mentor.

- The SEND Mentor works directly with the child at home and in the community.

Ongoing Support & Development:

- Regular supervision and training for the Mentor.
- Connection to community activities and additional professional support where needed.
- Attendance at MDTs, EHCP Annual Reviews, and contribution to review reports.
